Colorado Futuretek is a 501(C) (3) nonprofit corporation. Our mission is to provide enrichment training and resources to help African American and other underrepresented minority youth obtain marketable skills in the Information Technology and computer industries. We also focus on elevating our senior citizens by providing basic computer and smartphone training to increase their knowledge and comfort level with technology.

For years, African Americans have been underrepresented in Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) fields. Today, African Americans make up approximately 9% of the STEM workforce. Our programs target middle and high school students. Our instructors are STEM professionals and retired engineers and most are African Americans. This is important and a huge benefit because our students are able to interact with career professionals that look like them. The more we can expose our youth early on to STEM training and careers, the better chance we have in increasing the African American workforce in STEM fields.

We completed another successful year in 2024, serving a record number of students in SummerTEK 2024. Our 6-week SummerTEK 2024 program for high school students included the following courses:

- CCNA v7 Introduction to Computer Networks
- Introduction to Cybersecurity
- Entrepreneurship (ESB Certification) *
- Professional Communication Skills (CSB Certification) *

* In partnership with SparqU

We provided a summer STEAM! online camp for 5th through 8th grade students that included computer programming and a winter STEAM! workshop for middle and high school on financial literacy. We had great participation with our Summer SilverTeks and Silver Saturday's classes in the spring and fall. Students that have successfully completed SummerTEK served as paid tutors working with the seniors on their projects, under the direction of the lead instructor.










Student Program Overview

JULY 8 - 25, 2024 | MIDDLE SCHOOL





Interactive, fun, project-based learning each summer.

Our STEAM! Summer program introduces students in Grades 5-8 to Paint 3D, Minecraft programming, and financial literacy in a fun and interactive way. High school readiness is included for 7th & 8th grade students, putting them ahead of the crowd. In 2024, students built a 3D Underwater diorama—all from scratch. Students learned the basics of 3-dimensional design in Microsoft Paint 3D, how to use the tools to import, rotate, and place objects along a 3D plane.

Coding basics with Minecraft.

Students got an introductory experience with coding and computer science from Minecraft Hour of Code tutorials at Code.org. These tutorials taught students basic commands, loops, while statements, and do statements. Each student had to overcome obstacles and solve puzzles with code to make it to the end.

































STEAM! FUTURE


DECEMBER 2024 MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL

The basics for a strong financial foundation, and future.

STEAM! FUTURE is all about finance and this year was no different. Students learned the basics of a budget, how to create one, how to set financial goals, the difference between short-term and long term saving, and how to shop responsibly.

Students learned about credit basics, good and bad debt, and the importance of maintaining good credit. Additionally, Colorado Futuretek provided each child with a \$10 deposit to open a savings account.





SUMMERTEK

JUNE 10 - JULY 19, 2024 | HIGH SCHOOL

Valuable technology & business skills training, opening new opportunities.

SummerTEK is our opportunity for high school students to explore rewarding careers and to acquire valuable technology skills in a supportive and user-friendly environment. This year, 36 SummerTEK students earned Cisco Networking Academy certificates for the Networking and Cybersecurity courses, or certification from Certiport for the Entrepreneurship and Communication Skills courses.

Here is a description of the four exciting courses we held in SummerTEK 2024:

- CCNA v7 Introduction to Networks Students learned how the internet works and how to design computer networks for home and small businesses. The course introduced architectures, models, protocols, and networking simulations.
- **Introduction to Cybersecurity** Students developed an understanding of cybercrime, security principles, technologies, and procedures used to defend networks.
- Communication Skills for Business (CSB) Certification Course The core concepts included professional communication skills; effective verbal, nonverbal and listening skills; creating business deliverables; effectively delivering a message; receiving communications; and analyzing communication scenarios.
- Entrepreneurship (ESB Certification) The course covered business concepts, financial management, how to recognize a business opportunity, and how to turn an idea into a successful small business.

JUNE 10 - JULY 5, 2024 | SENIOR CITIZENS

Four weeks of M365 basics for senior citizens, guided by student tutors.

Summer SilverTeks is a 4-week, Monday through Friday course for senior citizens covering Microsoft 365 Office basics. Each senior is provided with worksheets and guidance from CFTEK student tutors. This year, seniors went through projects in Word, Excel, and Powerpoint, which helped them to transition from older versions of Microsoft Office to Microsoft 365.

Monthly projects that help seniors enhance their computer skills.

Silver Saturdays is a project-based class to help senior citizens learn the basics or improve their skills using laptops or smartphones. We teach skills in Microsoft 365. In 2024, seniors learned to create many things including a personal stationary in Word, Birthday Calendar in Excel, and Christmas Video Greeting in Powerpoint. Our student tutors worked one-on-one in Zoom breakout rooms, helping seniors with each project. Seniors also received individual tutoring sessions upon request.






